**Demand Capacity Surcharge Mechanism (“DCSM”) for Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid**

Dear Secretary Phillips:

The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid NY (“the Company”) hereby submits its Statement of Demand Capacity Surcharge Mechanism (“DCSM”) in compliance with Rule 57 of PSC No. 12 Gas Tariff.

The Company submits recovery for the Demand Response and Incremental Energy Efficiency Costs (not included in base delivery rates) components of the DCSM unit rate to be effective July 1, 2022. Since the DCSM rate is one of the components included in the Statement of Delivery Rate Adjustment (“DRA”), the DRA statement will be filed once all July 1<sup>st</sup> rate statements have been submitted.
