Re: Case 19-E-0380 – Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation Revenue Decoupling Mechanism Adjustment Statements

Dear Secretary Phillips:

In accordance with the Public Service Commission's <u>Order Establishing Rate Plan</u>, and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation's ("RG&E" or "the Company") tariff schedule, PSC No. 19, RG&E hereby files a Revenue Decoupling Mechanism ("RDM") Adjustment Statement to be effective April 1, 2022.

RDM Statement No. 16 to PSC No. 19

In accordance with PSC No. 19, Section 4.K. of RG&E's tariff schedule, if at any time during the Rate Year the cumulative difference between the actual billed delivery service revenue and the cumulative target revenue is 1.50% or more, the Company may file an interim RDM Adjustment.

Interim RDM Adjustment Statements are to be filed on not less than 10 days' notice. In accordance with Appendix FF of the Rate Plan and the tariff schedule sections referenced in the preceding paragraph, an interim RDM Adjustment is limited to no more than once per year, and will be recovered over the longer of four months or the end of the rate year. The interim RDM Adjustment rates filed herein will be in effect through July 31, 2022.
