The enclosed statements are transmitted electronically by New York State Electric & Gas Corporation ("NYSEG") and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation ("RG&E") for filing in compliance with the requirements of the Public Service Commission ("PSC" or "Commission") of the State of New York, to become effective April 1, 2022.

In accordance with its tariff, RG&E is initiating an interim reconciliation refund of (\$0.04882/therm) as a result of a projected over collection of gas costs. The interim reconciliation surcharge will remain in effect through August 2022.


