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Pursuant to General Information Section 0, Leaf 68, the Company has implemented an Interim GAC Reconciliation Surcharge for the twelve months ended August 31, 2022. The Company will continue to monitor its projections on a monthly basis and may adjust this interim reconcilation surcharge as needed.
