Reason for Filing

The Commission in its orders issued and effective April 14, 2022, in Cases 19-E-0566, 20-E-0543, 21-E-0536,¹ directed the Company to incorporate into the Tariff the revised Standardized Interconnection Requirements ("SIR") as shown in the appendices of the April Orders.

Pursuant to the April Orders, the Company is filing the Commission's revised SIR as Tariff Addendum SIR-15.

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¹ Order Approving Compliance Filings, With Clarifications (Cases 19-E-0566 and 20-E-0543), and Order Modifying Standardized Interconnection Requirements (Case 21-E-0536) (the "April Orders").

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Conclusion and Notice

Addendum SIR-15 is being filed on not less than five days' notice to become effective on May 1, 2022. As specified in the ordering clauses of the April Orders, the Commission waived the requirement for newspaper publication.
