Dear Secretary Phillips:

The leaves set forth below are filed by Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation (“Central Hudson” or “the Company”) on April 29, 2022 to become effective on September 1, 2022.

The purpose of this filing is to revise the tariff leaves listed above to include the recovery of conduit costs through the contribution by applicant set forth on the Statement of Underground Residential Distribution Contribution.

Effective September 1, 2022, the Company is seeking to make an adjustment to the costs in historic years for conduit installations based on actual calendar-year costs incurred. Actual conduit costs will be included in the five-year annual average of underground distribution lines. In historic years (prior to conduit installations), an average of actual calendar-year costs will be used as a proxy in the calculation for the outer years until five years of actual costs have been incurred.
