Dear Secretary Phillips:

The enclosed tariff leaf, issued by Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation (“RG&E” or the “Company”), is transmitted for filing in compliance with the requirements of Appendix 7-H (electronic tariff filing system) to the New York State Public Service Commission’s (“Commission”) Codes, Rules and Regulations (16 NYCRR Appendix 7-H). The leaf is proposed to become effective on July 1, 2022.

Purpose and Overview of Filing

The Company is filing a revision to their electric tariff to provide clarification regarding the Transition Charge exemption under the Excelsior Jobs program. The tariff currently states that customers participating in the Excelsior Jobs Program are exempt from the Transition Charge.

The Transition Charge is a cost collection mechanism to collect various surcharges on the customer bill. Customers participating in the Excelsior Jobs Program are exempt from paying the Non-Bypassable Charge and the EV Make Ready Surcharge¹ components of the Transition Charge. The Commission’s Order that approved the utility tariff filings to implement the Excelsior Jobs Program indicated that customers’

¹ Under the EV Make Ready Surcharge provision of the Company’s tariff schedule (PSC No. 19 – Leaf No. 84), the tariff provides that a customer that qualified for the Excelsior Jobs Program is exempt from paying the EV Make Ready Surcharge on the qualified load.

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incremental load served under the Excelsior Jobs Program is exempt from utility-specific non-marginal surcharges, such as a legacy Transition Charge or known as the Non-Bypassable Charge in RG&E's tariff schedule, however they would still be subject to all other Commission required surcharges². The Company is adding language under the Excelsior Jobs Program section of the tariff to add further clarification regarding the exemptions.

Publication

The Company respectfully requests the requirements of Section 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law regarding newspaper publication be waived as this change is housekeeping in nature and does not affect customer bills.
