Dear Secretary Phillips:

Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc. (the "Company") herein submits for filing its Statement of Market Supply Charge, Statement No. MSC-120, to its Schedule for Electric Service, P.S.C. No. 3-ELECTRICITY. This Statement is issued February 24, 2022, to become effective March 1, 2022.

The Market Supply Charges ("MSC") for March 2022 include a projection of March 2022 electric supply costs and a reconciliation of January 2022 electric supply costs and MSC recoveries and the Clean Energy Standard Supply Surcharge. This statement also includes a determination of the capacity and adder rates, Clean Energy Standard Supply Surcharge necessary for Day-Ahead Hourly Pricing customers, and a Generation Capacity Critical Peak Event Charge for Smart Home Rate customers pursuant to the Commission's Orders issued May 24, 2006, February 22, 2017, and March 14, 2019 in Case Nos. 03-E-0641, 15-E-0302 and 18-E-0549, respectively.

In January 2022, the Company under collected approximately \$2.5 million. Normally, this under collection would have been fully reconciled in the March 2022 MSC rates. The Company will defer, for future disposition, \$1.0 million of this under collection to mitigate the impact of the under collection on the March 2022 MSC rates. Interest will be accrued, at the Commission-approved rate for GAC refunds, on the deferred portion of the January 2022 under collection.

The Company also includes a copy of the workpapers used to determine the March 2022 MSC.
