RE: Case 21-E-0537, Changes to Rider T - Commercial Demand Response Programs

Dear Secretary Phillips:

On October 27, 2021, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the “Company”) made a tariff filing with the Public Service Commission proposing program changes to Rider T – Commercial Demand Response Programs in the Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity. The tariff changes were proposed to become effective on February 28, 2022.

At the request of the Staff of the Department of Public Service, the Company is postponing to March 31, 2022, the effective date of the tariff changes that were filed on October 27, 2021. Accordingly, the Company hereby submits Supplement No. 74 to P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity, to postpone the effective date of the tariff changes to March 31, 2022.

The Supplement is issued on 30 days’ notice and has an effective date of March 12, 2022. However, since the pending tariff leaves currently have an effective date of February 28, 2022, the Company requests that it be authorized to put the Supplement into effect on short notice, i.e., February 28, 2022. The Company respectfully requests waiver of notice requirements for the effective date change.
