Re: Case 19-G-0309 – Proceeding on Motion of the Commission as to the Rates, Charges, Rules and Regulations of The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid NY for Gas Service.

Dear Secretary Phillips:

In accordance with the Order Approving Joint Proposal, as Modified, and Imposing Additional Requirements (issued and effective August 12, 2021) in Case 19-G-0309 (the "Order"), The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid NY (the "Company") submits for filing the gas tariff leaves and statement listed on Attachment A hereto. Specifically, Ordering Clause No. 7 of the Order directed the Company to file, on not less than 30 days' notice, tariff revisions to effectuate the provisions adopted by the Order for Rate Year 3 to take effect on a temporary basis on April 1, 2022. In addition, the Company is filing as Attachment B the unit rate calculation for the Rate Adjustment Clause ("RAC"), to take effect as of April 1, 2022.

Per Ordering Clause No. 8 of the Order and as required by Public Service Law § 66-12 and 16 NYCRR § 720-8.1, the changes set forth in the revised tariff leaves for Rate Year 3 will be published in newspapers in the Company's service territory. The Company will file proof of publication with the Commission once all publications have been made.

This filing is made in accordance with Appendix 7-H (electronic filing system) to the Commission's Codes, Rules and Regulations (16 NYCRR, Appendix 7-H). As required by the Order, the active parties to Case 19-G-0309 have been copied on this filing.
