In accordance with General Information Sections 36.A of P.S.C. No. 15 - Electricity, the Statement listed below is filed by Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or "the Company") to become effective January 3, 2022.

P.S.C. No. 15 – Electricity

Statement of Systems Benefit Charge SBC - 46

Pursuant to the Company's tariff, the Company routinely files a Statement of System Benefits Charge ("SBC Statement") in December to be effective with the first billing batch of the Company's January billing cycle. The purpose of this filing is to correct the previously filed effective date of 1/4/2022 to 1/3/2022. The date of 1/4/2022 conflicts with our processing. Moreover, the purpose of this filing is to incorporate in the current collection factor the current annual assessment amounts and a reconciliation of recoveries (eleven months actual, one month forecast) with the prior year's requirements. Furthermore, pursuant to Case 20-M-0082, Integrated Energy Data Resource (IEDR) costs approved for recovery are included in the Clean Energy Fund surcharge. The Company has included Central Hudson's cost allocation of the 2021 and 2022 anticipated Phase I IEDR invoices per the November 2021 NYSERDA invoice for recovery over calendar year 2022.
