New York State Electric & Gas Corporation ("NYSEG") and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation ("RG&E"), (together the "Companies"), are submitting this filing in further compliance with the New York State Public Service Commission's (the "Commission") Order Adopting Net Metering Successor Tariff Filings with Modifications, issued and effective on August 13, 2021 (the "Order"), in the above-referenced proceeding. The Statements will become effective on January 1, 2022.

Purpose of Filing

The Companies are re-filing the Customer Benefit Contribution charge (CBC) Statements in compliance with Ordering Clause No. 2 of the Order and the Companies tariffs¹.

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The Companies Micro-combined Heat and Power (Micro CHP) service option is only available to residential customers with systems that have a rated capacity of not more than 10 kW, therefore, the CBC Charge does not apply to small commercial Micro-CHP distributed energy resources. The Companies are re-filing the statements to indicate that the CBC Charge doesn't apply to small commercial service classifications.
