Dear Secretary Phillips:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the “Company”) is filing with the Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) the following Statement of Purchase of Receivables (“POR”) Discount Percentage to its Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity (the “Electric Tariff”), applicable to its customers in the City of New York and the County of Westchester.

DISC - Statement of Purchase of Receivables Discount Percentage No. 5
to P.S.C No. 10 – Electricity

The Statement is being issued to become effective on January 1, 2022.

Reason for Filing

The Company is filing the Statement of POR Discount Percentage pursuant to General Rule 19.3.6 of the Electric Tariff. Under the POR program, the Company shall remit to the Energy Service Company (“ESCO”) undisputed ESCO charges billed to its customers, reduced by the POR Discount Percentage. The POR Discount Percentage, as shown on the statement, includes the Uncollectible Bill Percentage, Risk Factor, Credit & Collections, and Incremental Cost components.

The total POR Discount Percentage to be effective January 1, 2022, is 2.37%. In accordance with General Rule 19.3.6 of the Electric Tariff, the Company is filing its Statement of POR Discount Percentage no less than three days before the effective date.
