Re: Transition Adjustment for Competitive Services

Dear Secretary Phillips:

Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc. ("the Company") hereby submits for filing with the Public Service Commission (the "Commission") its Statement of Transition Adjustment for Competitive Services, Statement No. TACS – 14 to its Schedule for Electric Service, P.S.C. No. 3 – ELECTRICITY. This Statement is issued December 16, 2021, to become effective with service rendered on or after January 1, 2022.

This filing includes a reconciliation of the Company's Transition Adjustment for Competitive Services ("TACS") mechanism for the period January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021, and the determination of the TACS to become effective January 1, 2022. This filing is made in accordance with the provisions of the Joint Proposal adopted by the Commission in its Order Adopting Terms of Joint Proposal and Establishing Electric and Gas Rate Plans, issued March 14, 2019 in Case No. 18-E-0067.

Accordingly, the Company has determined that the TACS applicable to full service customers is a credit of 0.026 cents per kWh and the TACS applicable to retail access customers is a credit of 0.007 cents per kWh. The calculations supporting this determination are attached as Appendix A.
