RE: Annual Electric Vehicle Surcharge ("EVS") Filing

Dear Secretary Phillips:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the "Company") herein submits for filing its Statement of Electric Vehicle Make Ready Surcharge – EVS Statement No. 2 to its Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity (the "Tariff"). This Statement is issued January 14, 2022 to become effective February 1, 2022.

This filing is made in accordance with General Information Section 26.10 of the Company's Tariff which requires an annual EVS filing pursuant to the Commission's July 16, 2020 Order in Case 18-E-0138, Proceeding on Motion of the Commission Regarding Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment and Infrastructure.

The Company's current EVS surcharges are structured to: (1) allocate the costs to all service classifications in proportion to each class' delivery revenues; (2) provide for the recovery of the costs from non-demand billed service classifications on a kWh basis and from demand billed service classifications on a kW basis. For Customers billed on Standby Service rates the surcharge will be collected on a per kW of Contract Demand basis, or on a dollar per month basis. The surcharges per kWh or kW are determined by dividing allocable costs by estimated billed kWh deliveries or kW demands over the collection period.

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The proposed surcharges on EVS Statement No. 2 are based on annual actual Electric Vehicle Make Ready costs for the 2021 program year. The EVS surcharges will be reconciled annually at the end of each program year. Any over- or under-collection as a result of this reconciliation will be reflected in the following year's EVS surcharges. The resulting EVS surcharges per service classification for the 2021 program year can be found on EVS Statement No. 2.
