The above statements are being filed in accordance with Rule 52 - Electric Vehicle Make-Ready ("EVMR") Surcharge in PSC No. 220 Electricity. Attachment 1 displays the unit rate calculation based on the costs to recover, allocated by service classification in proportion to each service classification's transmission and distribution revenue, and then divided by the forecasted usage by service classification. Attachment 2 displays the summary of current deferred costs for the Company's EVMR program allowed under Case 18-E-0138. Attachment 3 contains the calculation of the revenue requirement associated with Company-owned Make-Ready expenditures as described in PSC No. 220 Electricity tariff rule 52.1.1.

The EVMR Surcharge Statement is to be filed with the Commission on not less than fifteen (15) business days notice before the effective date. The EVMR Surcharge Statement No. 2 is effective January 28, 2022 for batch billed customers and February 1, 2022 for calendar month billed customers.
