Dear Secretary Phillips:

In accordance with Commission rules, Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or the "Company") hereby files the following electric tariff supplement:

The purpose of this filing is to further postpone until March 1, 2022 the effective date of the following tariff leaf which was initially filed on March 30, 2020:

A filing by the Company to further postpone this tariff leaf was made at the request by Staff of the NYS Public Service Commission in order to allow additional time for the generic proceeding in Case 15-E-0751 on Standby and Buyback Service Rate Design to be settled on by the Commission prior to making changes to utility tariffs. The aforementioned filing to request postponement, by supplement 121, was previously submitted with an erroneous effective date. The purpose of this filing is to correct the effective date and request that the supplement becomes effective on December 31, 2021, on short notice.

The Company also requests a waiver of newspaper publication requirements of Public Service Law §66(12)(b) for this filing.
