The attached statement, issued by Niagara Mohawk, d/b/a/ National Grid ("Company"), is being transmitted for filing in accordance with the requirements of the New York State Public Service Commission ("Commission"):

> Statement of Supply Service Charges No. 152 To P.S.C. No. 214 Electricity Effective: April 30, 2024

The above statement is being filed in accordance with Rule No. 46.4-Supply Service Charges in PSC No. 220 Electricity. Attachment 1 of this filing displays the derivation of these charges. Additionally, this statement reflects changes to the Capacity Tag setting process to reallocate the differences between the Corporate Load Coincident Peak and the Company's Load Research developed Coincident Peak back to just the load profiled classes. This change is reflected in the Supply Service Adjustement of ESRM for load profiled customers. Also included in this statement is the Legacy Transition Charge ("LTC") in accordance with Rule No. 46.2 in PSC No. 220 Electricity. Beginning with this month's filing, the LTC rate includes, for the benefit of all delivery customers, net revenues from the East Pulaski energy storage system, which began bidding into the wholesale markets in March 2024.

This Supply Service Charge Statement is to be filed with the Commission on not less than three (3) business days notice before the effective date. Supply Service Statement No. 152 is effective April 30, 2024 for batch billed customers, and May 1, 2024 for calendar month billed customers.
