The above statement is being filed in accordance with Rule No. 46.4-Supply Service Charges in PSC No. 220 Electricity. Attachment 1 of this filing displays the derivation of these charges. Also, included in this statement is the residential agricultural discount rate in accordance with Rule No. 46.2.6.7 in PSC No. 220 Electricity. Please note that the Company's Supply Cost revenues, Electricity Supply Reconciliation Mechanism revenues, and Legacy Transition Charge revenues for November 2023 were adjusted to account for rebates issued to customers under the Residential Electric Vehicle Charge Smart Plan under Special Provision N of Service Classification No. 1 in PSC No. 220.

This Supply Service Charge Statement is to be filed with the Commission on not less than three (3) business days notice before the effective date. Supply Service Statement No. 148 is effective December 29, 2023 for batch billed customers, and January 1, 2024 for calendar month billed customers.
