The purpose of the filing is to update the service-establishment and disconnection charges contained in Rule No. 20 of P.S.C. 218 Gas. The charges were last revised effective September 14, 1992.

The current and proposed re-establishment charges are as follows:

Attachment 1 shows the development of the proposed reestablishment charge components. Attachment 2 shows the application of those cost components to the work that is done when service is reestablished. The methods employed to develop the proposed charges are the same approach used when the charges were last revised and initiated, however, the variable inputs have been updated to reflect current work conditions and hourly pay rates.

The revenue impacts of this proposal are illustrated in Attachment 3. The 1992 service re-establishments are shown using present and proposed rates. Repricing these re-establishments at the proposed rates results in an annual revenue increase of \$225,489.00 for 2000.

Newspaper publication of the proposed new re-establishment charges will be made in accordance with 16 NYCRR 236.70 on August 23, 30, September 6 and 13, 2000.
