The purpose of this filing is to comply with the PSC's Order "Modifying Opinion No. 76-17 and Establishing Criteria for Classifying Senior Living Facilities in Case 99-E-1797" issued and effective March 28, 2000. The Order provides for the exemption of facilities classified as "senior living facilities" from the individual metering requirement originally adopted by the Public Service Commission in Opinion 76-17. Central Hudson's tariffs have been revised to reflect this modification as well as to require the Company to use and administer the following criteria for classifying senior living facilities:

- the senior living facility will provide services that distinguish it from a typical apartment complex and its design will be energy efficient, resulting in electricity usage that does not vary significantly among residential units;
- 2) the facility will continue to offer senior living services in the future; and
- 3) the facility will promote economic development.
