#### **Proposed Revisions**

Per Staff's request, NYSEG submits these further revised leaves to clarify certain portions of its tariff submitted in compliance with the Commission's Opinion and Order Concerning Uniform Business Practices, issued February 16, 1999, as modified by the Commission's Notice to the Parties issued March 5, 1999, and the Commission's Order Granting Portions of Petitions for Rehearing, issued April 15, 1999 (collectively the "UBP Orders"). The filing removes the requirement that a Direct Customer be daily metered.

#### **Background**

Uniform Business Practices were set forth by the Commission in Opinion and Order Concerning Uniform Business Practices, issued February 16, 1999, as modified by the Commission's Notice to the Parties issued March 5, 1999, and the Commission's Order Granting Portions of Petitions for Rehearing, issued April 15, 1999 (collectively the "UBP Orders").

#### **Notification**

Per Ordering Clause No. 2 of the Commission's February 16, 1999 Order, the requirement of §66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication of the revisions is waived.
