Reasons for Proposed Revisions

This filing is being submitted to make further "housekeeping" revisions to NYSEG's gas tariffs to make them correct and up-to-date.

Proposed Revisions

On November 12, 1999, NYSEG submitted "housekeeping" revisions to its gas tariffs in Case No. 99-G-1593. The leaves are to become effective on January 1, 2000. Since that time, Staff requested that NYSEG make further tariff revisions in compliance with Case No. 98-M-1343. This filing was submitted to the Commission on December 10, 1999 and become effective on December 11, 1999. Two tariff leaves contained in PSC No. 88 were revised in both of these filings. Therefore, it has become necessary to file these revisions in order to make the tariff current and up-to-date.

Customer Impact Assessment

These revisions will have no impact on NYSEG's gas customers.

Newspaper Publication & SAPA

NYSEG requests waiver of publication of this proposed change in accordance with 16 NYCRR Part 270.70, as these "housekeeping" revisions have NO direct impact to NYSEG's gas customers.

Special Requests

Pursuant to 16 NYCRR Part 720.2.4, NYSEG respectfully requests that these leaves be allowed to become effective on January 1, 2000, the initial effective date of its original "housekeeping" filing in Case No. 99-G-1593.

NYSEG requests a waiver from the applicable sections of 16 NYCRR Part 270 to allow for the new electronic format.
