The proposed revision is issued as of today for an effective date of February 15, 2003. The Company requests that the Supplement be given "short notice" effective January 31, 2003 to the extent necessary.

Explanation of Filing

On June 21, 2002, Distribution submitted tariff amendments proposing a "Partnership for Distributed Generation" pilot program. On September 12, 2002 and at the request of Staff, Distribution filed an amendment postponing the filing for sixty days. On November 24, 2000 Distribution filed an amendment further postponing the proposed tariff amendments until December 24, 2002 to comply with Commission's order issued and effective November 19, 2002. On December 5, 2002 Distribution again filed an amendment further postponing the proposed tariff amendments until February 1, 2003. Staff has requested that the filing be further postponed. Thus, the sole purpose of this filing is to further postpone the proposed tariff amendments until March 22, 2003.

Newspaper Publication

The Company has met the requirement for newspaper publication and provided proof of the proposed service by letter to the Commission dated November 8, 2002.
