Reasons for Proposed Revisions

This filing is being submitted to make "housekeeping" revisions to NYSEG's gas tariffs to make them correct and up-to-date.

Proposed Revisions

Leaf No. 10 to PSC No. 87 and Leaf No. 8 to PSC No. 88 are being revised to add language regarding the MTA tax surcharge that was inadvertently omitted in a previous filing. Leaf No. 13.1 to PSC No. 87 and Leaf No. 50.14 to PSC No. 88 are being revised to correctly define voluntarily switching. Leaf No. 103 to PSC No. 88 is being revised to remove language that should have been removed in a previous tariff filing.

Customer Impact Assessment

These revisions will have no impact on NYSEG's gas customers.

Newspaper Publication & SAPA

NYSEG requests waiver of publication of this proposed change in accordance with 16 NYCRR Part 270.70, as these "housekeeping" revisions have no direct impact to NYSEG's gas customers.
