On October 28, 1997, Niagara Mohawk filed tariff revisions to implement a fixed price option for the 1997-1998 heating season in accordance with the Commission's Order in Case No. 97-G-0600. On June 5, 1998, the Commission issued an Order "Allowing the Offering of Fixed Price Options" for the 1998-1999 heating season. The order does not require local distribution companies to offer the fixed price option for another year and Niagara Mohawk does not intend to continue with their fixed price option. Therefore, the above tariff revisions will remove the fixed price option from Niagara Mohawk's tariff.

Ordering Paragraph 3 of the Commission's June 5, 1998 order included waiver of the newspaper publication requirements of Section 66(12) of the Public Service Law and 16 NYCRR 270.70.
