These leaves are being filed to implement the Gas Restructuring Joint Proposal recently approved by the Commission. Case 99-G-1469, Petition of The Brooklyn Union Gas Company and KeySpan Gas East Corporation for a Multi-Year Restructuring Agreement, *Order Adopting Terms of Gas Restructuring Joint Proposal*, (May 23, 2002). Section IV.F. of the Joint Proposal provides that "As soon as practicable, and no later than 30 days after the Implementation Date [of the Joint Proposal],

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KeySpan LI will file tariff leaves to implement a daily balancing program for Interruptible Transportation Customers."

The enclosed leaves provide a daily balancing program for non-utility gas suppliers (Marketers) who serve pools of large volume customers. Under this program:

- KED LI will provide daily balancing service to Marketers for their entire service pools
- Daily pool consumption data will be available to the Marketer on a 24 hour lag basis via KED LI's Electronic Bulletin Board
- Individual customer consumption data will be sent to the Marketer daily on a 24 hour lag basis via electronic mail
- Marketers will be given the latitude to determine the daily delivery quantity for their service pools with no minimum or maximum requirements imposed by KED LI
- Cash outs will be determined daily, and will be billed monthly
- Daily cash out prices and penalties will be calculated as follows:

Overdeliveries:

0 - 10% over the daily delivery quantity will be purchased at the New York Transco Zone 6 Midpoint price as reported in Gas Daily for the day(s) in question, with no penalty

>10 - 20% over the daily delivery quantity will be purchased at 80% of the Transco Zone 6 Midpoint price as reported in Gas Daily for the day(s) in question

>20% over the daily delivery quantity will be purchased at 50% of the Transco Zone 6 Midpoint price as reported in Gas Daily for the day(s) in question

Underdeliveries:

0 - 10% under the daily delivery quantity will be charged KED LI's Weighted Average Commodity Cost of Gas, with no penalty

>10 - 20% under the daily delivery quantity will be charged 120% of KED LI's Weighted Average Commodity Cost of Gas

>20% under the daily delivery quantity will be charged 150% of KED LI's Weighted Average Commodity Cost of Gas + \$10 dth
