The Company is filing the above listed tariff leaves in compliance with the Commission's February 14, 2000 order in Case 99-G-1369. The Commission's February 14, 2000, order approved the New York Gas Group's petition to establish a voluntary state funding mechanism to support medium and long-term gas research and development programs. In addition, the order allows each local distribution company to file tariff revisions to provide for a surcharge to firm sales and firm transportation customers. The order requires that the surcharge not exceed the decrement in the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) surcharge currently used to support broad-based gas related research and development conducted by the Gas Research Institute. In addition, the order requires that the FERC surcharge be capped at \$.0174 per dekatherm after 2004. The above tariff provision adds Rule 30 to the General Information Section of P.S.C. No. 218 in order to provide for the Research and Development Surcharge Mechanism.

Newspaper publication of the proposed changes as required by $16 \, \text{NYCRR} \ 720 - 8.1$ will be made on April 5, 12, 19 and 26, 2000.
