The purpose of this filing is to comply with Ordering Paragraph 1 of the above Order which directs the Company to incorporate into our electric tariff Standard Interconnection Requirements and revised Photovoltaic Interconnection Standards set forth in the appendices to the Order.

All tariff provisions related to Distributed Generation have been included in General Information Section 3.C. Distributed Generation Interconnection Requirements.

In addition to the interconnection requirements for distributed generation units, the Order also required the utilities to incorporate the updated Photovoltaic Interconnection Standards attached as Appendix B to the Order. Since the Photovoltaic Interconnection Standards are not included in CHG&E's tariffs, no tariff change is necessary. However, CHG&E has updated its Residential Photovoltaic Interconnection Agreement, which is referenced in the tariff to incorporate the new interconnection standards.

As specified in Ordering Paragraph 1, "The requirement of Section 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication of these amendments is waived".
