#### **Reasons for Proposed Revisions**

In compliance with the Commission's April 30, 1997 order in the subject case, NYSEG is modifying its June 10, 1996 filing as directed. Further, this revision is being made to the Company's new electronic sales tariff, PSC No. 87, which supersedes P.S.C. No. 73, 75, 76, 79, 82 and 86.

#### **Proposed Revisions**

This revision clarifies the eligibility requirements for residential customers.

#### **Customer Impact Assessment**

There is no negative impact on any customer as a result of this filing. Affected customers will receive a lower minimum charge and will not be required to pay a monthly adjustment for gas costs.

In compliance with Ordering Clause No. 4 of the April 30, 1997 order, NYSEG will notify its customers of these revisions by means of a bill insert and will submit a copy of the notification to Commission Staff of the Consumer Services Division.

## **Special Requests**

NYSEG requests a waiver from the applicable sections of 16 NYCRR Part 270 to allow for the new electronic format.
