On June 13, 2002, the Company filed revisions to Rule 16 - Special Services Performed By Company for Customer at a Charge. Specifically, the filing added Rule 16.4 in order to allow customers to request the Company provide demand pulse capability on their gas meters to enable the customer to receive electronic pulse information for input into customer-owned energy management systems. The June 13, 2002 filing also modified Rule 13.5 which contains procedures for customers who are required to install Approved Remote Meters (ARMs).

On September 19, 2002, the Commission approved the Company's June 13, 2002 filing subject to revisions providing for an allowance of one "no-charge" visit per ARM customer when the problem is determined to reside solely with the customer's equipment.

The above listed tariff leaves are filed in compliance with the Commission's September 19, 2002 Order. As required by Ordering Paragraph 2, the tariff revisions are being filed effective November 1, 2002.
