Effective October 28, 2000

On July 31, 2000, the Company filed its compliance filing in Case 99-G-0336. This filing was filed in compliance with the Commission's Order approving the Settlement Agreement issued July 27, 2000 in Case 99-G-0336. The Company has reviewed the filing with the Commission's staff and have a number of minor changes of a housekeeping nature to make to the compliance filing.

The tariff filing made herein implements those housekeeping changes.

Leaf No. 127 has been filed to correct the DDF factor for the month of October for S.C. 2 Commercial Heat to .46648 and the DDF factor for the month of November for S.C. 2 Commercial Heat to .46135. The original tariff leaf contained typos in these two classes.

Leaf No. 133 has been revised to eliminate the reference to S.C. 12 and S.C. 13 which have been discontinued.

Leaf Nos. 140, 140.1, 141, and 142 are being revised at the request of the Commission's staff in order to clarify the Title of S.C. 3 as being Large General Delivery and Gas Supply Service.

Leaf No. 160 and 153 have been modified to correct the dates which the balancing charge will be charged to the Marketer rather than the customer.

Leaf 184 is being revised in order to add definitions of City Gate Swing Customer and Delivery Point Operator, as requested by the Commission's staff.

Leaf Nos. 192 and 193 have deleted the reference to Scheduling Charges which should have been deleted as a result of the implementation of the new Monthly Balancing program.

Leaf Nos. 194, 194.1, 195,, and 196 have been changed solely to re-letter the paragraphs which is required due to deletions on Leaf 192 and 193.

Leaf Nos. 198 through 206 are former S.C. 12 and S.C. 13 tariff leaves. As these Service Classes are being discontinued, as part of the settlement, they should have been "Reserved for Future Use". This filing corrects that omission.

The Company requests waiver of newspaper publication as required by 16NYCRR 720-8.1 as the changes filed herein are of a housekeeping nature and the original rate case filing was previously advertised.
