The purpose of this filing is to comply with Ordering Paragraph 3 of the above Order which directs the Company to incorporate verbatim into our electric tariffs the revised Standard Interconnection Requirements (including standardized applications and contracts) set forth in the November 15, 2000 Order's appendix. Central Hudson's applications have been modified to comply with all information set forth in the Order, as well one additional information requirement for the Customer Account number.

In addition to the interconnection requirements for distributed generation units, the Order also required the utilities to incorporate the updated Photovoltaic Interconnection Standards attached as Appendix B to Opinion 99-13, issued December 31, 2000 in this same proceeding.

As specified in Ordering Paragraph 3, "The requirement of Section 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication of these amendments is waived".
