By Order issued April 3, 2001 in Case No. 99-E-0503, the Commission directed Niagara Mohawk to file a plan within 60 days of the effective date of this Order to (1) provide notice to affected customers of eligibility for residential rates pursuant to Public Service Law 76; (2) to identify, upon request, other religious entities similarly situated as the City Mission Society; (3) provide residential rates to any accounts improperly classified; and (4) to provide six years of refunds from the date of a request for a billing at the residential rate. On May 31, 2001, and further revised May 17, 2002, Niagara Mohawk filed a plan and tariff amendments to more clearly define its eligibility criteria for entry into residential rates pursuant to this Order.

On June 28, 2002 the Commission issued an Order directing the Company to make further revisions to these filings pursuant to this Order to become effective on not less than one day\*s notice on July 7, 2002. The above leaves are being filed in Compliance with this order and contain revisions as documented in this Order.

Also, Ordering Clause 2 of the June 28, 2002 Order waives newspaper publication as required in Section 66(12)(b) and 16NYCRR 720-8.1 since the Company will be sending a letter to all affected customers informing them of their options under the terms and conditions set forth in the plan.
