KeySpan Gas East Corporation d/b/a KeySpan Energy Delivery Long Island ("Company") hereby
files electronically the following tariff leaves to become effective January 1, 2001:

These leaves are being filed in compliance with the Commission's December 26, 2000 Order
Establishing Interim Rate Plan and Order Modifying Interim Rate Plan in this proceeding. Leaf
No. 79.3 establishes the \$50.00 one-time bill credit against delivery charges paid by the
Company's sales and transportation heating customers if the December cost of gas exceeds \$5.15
per dekatherm.

Leaf No. 156 incorporates the incentive payment to marketers equal to 8% of the delivery charges
incurred by the marketer's firm service customers each month.

Leaf No. 119.28 provides for pro rata sharing by the Company and the marketers of amounts the Company collects from customers where it provides a single combined bill for delivery and commodity charges. The Company notes that Leaf Nos. 119.50 - 119.55 addressing the single bill option in compliance with the Commission's March 22, 2000 Order Providing for Customer Choice of Billing Entity in Case No. 99-M-0631 remain under suspension in that proceeding.

Leaf Nos. 139, 161, 177 and 183 all reflect the loss factor reduction from 4% to 3%.
