Pursuant to the provisions of Section 270.55 and 270.57 of Title 18 of the Official Compilation of Codes, Rules and Regulations of the State of New York, we are electronically transmitting the following Statement:

Statement No. 32 "Statement of Cost of Gas and Adjustments" effective **May 1, 2001**, which sets forth the amount of adjustment applicable to monthly usage under Service Classification Nos. 1A, 1AR, 1B, 1BR, 2 and 3 of PSC No. 12-GAS, and the amount of adjustment applicable to usage under Service Classification Nos. 4A, 4B, 7 and 14 of PSC No. 12-GAS.

The following tiered floor prices will take effect on May 1, 2001 unless otherwise revised by a supplemental filing to account for major changes in gas prices and supplies, as follows:

- ! \$5.671/dth for sales to Service Classification Nos. 5A and 5B.
- ! \$5.206/dth for sales to Service Classification Nos. 6C, 6G, and 6M.

The first tier price of **5.671**/dth represents Brooklyn Union's incremental cost of gas to serve S.C. No. 5A, and 5B customers plus an allowance for lost-and unaccounted-for-gas.

The second tier price of \$5.206/dth represents Brooklyn Union's firm weighted average cost of gasto serve S.C. No. 6C, 6G and 6M customers plus an allowance for lost-and unaccounted-forgas and an allocated demand charge.

Brooklyn Union reserves the right to revise the floor price, as may be necessary to reflect significant changes in the components of this calculation. In addition, the Company fully intends to reflect the current floor price on the Statement of Standard Offer Price - S.C. 5A as filed with the Commission.
