Effective: May 1, 2006

This Statement of Commodity Adjustment Charge (CAC) is being filed per Rule No. 29—Delivery Charge Adjustment (DCA). Specifically, Rule No. 29.2 describes the calculation of the CAC which adjusts the Delivery Charge Adjustment prices for deviations between actual costs of unhedged energy and capacity for purchased power and Electricity Supply Service (ESS) revenues collected from customers through their service bills.

Statement of Commodity Adjustment Charge No. 55 is effective May 1, 2006 for batch billings and May 1, 2006 for calendar month billings.
