Addendum SIR No. 8 – Standardized Interconnection Requirements

The purpose of these amendments is to:

1. extend the dollar method for crediting demand-metered farm waste customers to the demand-metered solar customers newly entitled to net metering;
2. extend the kWh credit methodology applied to non-demand residential solar customers to all non-demand net metering customers;
3. revise the provisions applicable to any annual credit accumulated by non-residential, net-metered solar customers to provide for the carry forward of such credits to succeeding billing periods;
4. tariff specific language addressing the ability of non-residential, demand-metered solar customers to petition the Commission for a determination of rated capacity;
5. simplify the estimation of rated capacity for non-residential, non-demand-metered solar customers to allow them to size their generators up to the demand-metering threshold;
6. clarify cost responsibility for metering configuration requirements and elections; and,
7. conform the Company's tariff to the Standardized Interconnection Requirements adopted by the Commission on February 13, 2009 in Case 08-E-1018.

As directed in Ordering Clause No. 3 of the Commission's February 13, 2009 Order in this Case, the requirements of 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication have been waived.
