The enclosed statements, issued by Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation ("RG&E" or the "Company"), are transmitted for filing in compliance with the requirements of the Public Service Commission ("PSC" or "Commission") of the State of New York:

In compliance with 16 NYCRR 720-6.5(g), RG&E is initiating a surcharge beginning with the first billing cycle of January 2009 and continuing through December 2009, as a result of the Company's annual reconciliation of gas costs for the period September 1, 2007 to August 31, 2008.

In compliance with the Commission Order, issued and effective May 20, 2004 in Case 03-G-0766, Order Adopting Provisions of Joint Proposals with Conditions, RG&E is updating the calculation of the Merchant Function Charge (MFC) and the calculation of the Factor of Adjustment (FA). As stated in the May 20, 2004 Order, beginning January 1, 2005 and each 12-month period thereafter, the gas supply uncollectibles and gas inventory carrying charges calculations, both components of the MFC, are to be updated. Also, the FA is to be reset on January 1, 2005 and every year thereafter unless and until a new gas rate plan approved by the Commission becomes effective.

These rates will continue in effect until there are changes in the cost of gas that require modifications.
