RE: CASE 06-G-1185 – Proceeding on Motion of the Commission as to the Rates, Charges, Rules and Regulations of The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a KeySpan Energy Delivery New York For Gas Service – Bill Format Compliance

Dear Secretary Brilling:

In accordance with the Public Service Commission of the State of New York's ("Commission") "Order Adopting Gas Rate Plans For KeySpan Energy Delivery New York and KeySpan Energy Delivery Long Island" dated December 21, 2007 in the above proceeding ("December 21 Order"), The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a KeySpan Energy Delivery New York ("KEDNY") hereby submits one copy of the revised tariff leaves listed in Appendix A, which are being issued by KEDNY to its Schedule for Gas Service, PSC No. 12 to become effective on a temporary basis on and after October 1, 2008. The purpose of the revised tariff leaves is to set forth KEDNY's proposed rates and charges in the manner in which they will appear on the reformatted bill that will be implemented on October 1, 2008.

Under KEDNY's current tariff, the Customer Billing Charge is reflected in the Minimum Charge for Service Classification Nos. 1A, 1AR, 1B, 1BI, 1BR, 1B-DG, 2-1, 2-2, 3, 4A, 4A-CNG, 4B, 7, 17 and 21. Any transportation customer that receives a consolidated bill receives a billing credit of \$0.76 per bill. Under the revised billing format approved by the Commission in its December 21 Order,¹ the Customer Billing Charge will be removed from the Minimum Charge and reflected in a separately stated Customer Billing Charge of \$0.76 per bill. The revised tariff leaves are necessary to implement this change.

¹ See December 21 Order at 57 adopting the terms of the Gas Rates Joint Proposal dated October 10, 2007 ("JP-4") at 35 and Appendix H. The revised billing format will take effect July 1, 2008. Under that format, the Customer Billing Charge is separately stated.

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Additionally, there will now be a Delivery Rate Adjustment ("DRA") appearing on customers' bills taking service under Service Classification Nos. 1A, 1AR, 1B, 1BI, 1BR, 1B-DG, 2-1, 2-2, 3, 4A, 4A-CNG, 4B, 7, 14, 17 and 21. The DRA will consist of the Delivery Rate Surcharge and, where applicable to heating customers, the Weather Normalization Adjustment. Previously, the Delivery Rate Surcharge was collected via the Gas Adjustment Clause or the Transportation Adjustment Clause. The Weather Normalization Adjustment Clause.

KEDNY requests that the Commission approve this compliance filing as soon as possible. To the extent that any waivers of the Commission's regulations are necessary to allow such approval, KEDNY requests that they be granted. Copies of this filing are being served electronically on all active parties to this proceeding.
