<u>PSC No. 19 – Electricity, Schedule for Electric Service</u> Addendum - UBP No. 5

Effective November 1, 2008.

The above tariff addenda are being filed pursuant to the Commission's <u>Order</u> <u>Adopting Amendments to the Uniform Business Practices, Granting in Part Petition on</u> <u>Behalf of Customers and Rejecting National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation's Tariff</u> <u>Filing</u>, issued October 27, 2008 (the "Order").

Ordering Clause 5 of the Order directs utilities to file revised Uniform Business Practices ("UBP") Addenda. The revisions that were approved in Ordering Clause 1 specify marketing practices and implement remedies to redress violations of those practices, and improve disclosure requirements to address issues with ESCO marketing practices and sales agreements. Accordingly, revised electric and gas UBP addenda reflecting the approved revisions to the UBP are filed herein.

Requirements of Public Service Law Section 66 (12) (b) as to newspaper publication of the tariff revisions are waived pursuant to Ordering Clause 6 of the Order.
