Dear Secretary Brilling:

Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc. is filing today with the Public Service Commission (the "Commission") a revised addendum, Addendum-UBP-5, to its Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 4 – Gas. Addendum-UBP-5 is being filed to incorporate the revised Uniform Business Practices ("UBP") as set forth in Appendix B, and adopted by Ordering Clause 1, of the Order Adopting Amendments to the Uniform Business Practices, Granting in Part Petition on Behalf of Customers and Rejecting National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation's Tariff Filing, issued and effective October 27, 2008 (the "October 2008 Order") in the above referenced proceedings.

Because the revised UBP that was approved by the Commission's October 2008 Order is applicable to ESCO-customer contracts entered into, or contract renewals, on or after November 1, 2008, the UBP that was issued in November 2006 remains in effect for ESCO-customer contracts entered into before November 1, 2008. As a result, Addendum UBP-5 has two parts: Part A is applicable to contracts entered into before November 1, 2008, and incorporates verbatim the text of Addendum-UBP-4 (which is the text of the UBP approved by the Order Adopting ESCO Price Reporting Requirements and Enforcement Mechanisms, issued and effective November 8, 2006, in Case Nos. 06-M-0647 and 98-M-1343, and adopted by Ordering Clause 2 of that order); and Part B is applicable to contracts entered into, or contract renewals, on or after November 1, 2008, and incorporates verbatim the UBP text approved by the October 2008 Order.

As directed by Ordering Clause 5 of the October 2008 Order, Addendum-UBP-5 is being filed on not less than one day's notice to become effective on November 1, 2008. As specified in Ordering Clause 6 of the October 2008 Order, the requirement for newspaper publication has been waived.
