New York State Electric & Gas Corporation ("NYSEG" or "the Company") hereby submits for filing the following enclosed tariff leaves in compliance with the requirements of the New York State Public Service Commission ("PSC" or "Commission") and Appendix 7-H (electronic tariff filing system) to the Commission's Codes, Rules and Regulations (16 NYCRR Appendix 7-H).

Proposed Revisions

This filing is submitted to make "housekeeping" revisions to NYSEG's gas tariffs. On December 28, 2006, the Company filed tariff revisions in compliance with the Commission's Order Denying Tariff Amendments, issued December 22, 2006, to modify each service classification to include a statement that the basic service charge includes \$0.70 of bill issuance costs. Tariff revisions were inadvertently not included in that filing for Service Classification No. 3 of PSC 87 and Service Classification Nos. 7 and 15 of PSC 88. The enclosed tariff leaves have been revised to include the bill issuance cost statement for these Service Classifications. Also, on Leaf No. 38 of PSC 87, the definition of the minimum charge has been clarified to include the Basic Service Charge, which is determined by multiplying the MDSQ by the Standby

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Demand Charge. Finally, on Leaf No. 60 of PSC 88, the term “Basic Service Charge” has been corrected to state “Transportation Administration Charge”.

Newspaper Publication and SAPA

NYSEG requests waiver of publication of these proposed changes in accordance with Section 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law and 16 NYCRR Section 720-8.1, as these “housekeeping” revisions have no direct impact on NYSEG’s gas customers.
