The attached leaf, issued by Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation, d/b/a National Grid ("Company"), is being transmitted for filing in accordance with the requirements of the Public Service Commission, State of New York:

Second Revised Leaf No. 236

To PSC No. 219 Gas

Effective: December 18, 2006

The purpose of this filing is of a housekeeping/conforming nature to revise the Sales or Delivery Service Application Form for Non-Residential Service Customers contained in PSC No. 219 Gas.

On December 4, 1998 and April 15, 2005 (as further revised on June 23, 2005), the Company submitted filings proposing to revise the Non-Residential Service Application Form. These filings proposed to make the application form for non residential service less complicated for our customers and to automate the process where possible. These revisions were approved by the Commission in Case Nos. 98-G-1324 and 05-G-0458 issued and effective December 17, 1998 and July 20, 2005, respectively.

It has recently come to the attention of the Company that a section of this form was inadvertently deleted when these forms were revised in the above noted filings. Specifically, Section 7-Energy Profile, contained language that stated customers have the right to request that the Company perform an inspection to assure the accuracy of their meter(s) when signing this form. As stated above, this line was inadvertently deleted with the previous revisions of the form. Subsection D on Leaf No. 236 has been added proposing to reinstate this previous language to the form.

Because this leaf is being revised in a housekeeping/conforming nature, it is respectfully requested that this leaf become effective on less than statutory time, on December 18, 2006, so the amendments contained herein conform to the existing provisions contained within the tariff at the earliest possible date.

Also, the Company requests waiver of newspaper publication of the proposed changes as required by 16NYCRR 720-8.1 in that the modification is of a housekeeping/conforming nature and has no material effect on the Company's ratepayers.

Please advise the undersigned of any action taken with respect to this filing.
