Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison" or the "Company") is filing with the Public Service Commission ("Commission") Supplement No. 29 to its Schedule for Gas Service, PSC No. 9 – Gas ("Gas Tariff").

On April 1, 2005, in compliance with the Commission's Order dated September 27, 2004 in the above-referenced proceeding, the Company filed with the Commission amendments to its Gas Tariff in order to implement a marketer assignment program ("April Filing"). The specific leaves being revised bore an effective date of August 1, 2005.

Subsequent to the April 1, 2005 filing, the Company (at the request of Staff) issued Supplement Nos. 24 and 25, postponing the effective date of the tariff leaves to April 1, 2006 and November 1, 2006, respectively.

Staff has requested that the Company should further postpone this filing until August 1, $2007.^{2}\,$
