Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison" or the "Company") is filing with the Public Service Commission ("Commission") Supplement No. 28 to its Schedule for Gas Service, PSC No. 9 - Gas ("Gas Tariff") to cancel tariff amendments previously filed by the Company in the subject case.

On February 23, 2006, Con Edison filed amended Leaf 118.1, Revision 2, in order to include in the Gas Tariff a re-inspection fee for (or to be imposed on) gas contractors when a re-inspection is required after an initial failed final inspection. The revised Leaf bore an effective date of June 1, 2006. On May 15, 2006, in response to Staff's request, the Company postponed the effective date of the tariff amendments to August 1, 2006. On June 28, 2006, following Staff's request, the Company agreed to further postpone the effective date of the tariff amendments to September 1, 2006.

By order issued and effective August 28, 2006, in Case 06-G-0231 (the "August 28<sup>th</sup> Order"), the Commission rejected the tariff amendments filed on February 23, 2006. In compliance with the August 28<sup>th</sup> Order, the Company hereby files Supplement No. 28 canceling Leaf 118.1, Revision 2, that was to become effective September 1, 2006. In accordance with Ordering Clauses 2 and 5 of the August 28<sup>th</sup> Order, the Company requests that Supplement No. 28 be put into effect on one day's notice and that the requirement for newspaper publication be waived.
