New York State Electric & Gas Corporation ("NYSEG" or "the Company") hereby submits for filing the following enclosed tariff leaves in compliance with the New York Public Service Commission's ("Commission's") Order Extending Deadline and Continuing Standby Rate Exemption, in Case 02-E-0779, issued and effective May 23, 2006 (the "Order"). This filing is also made in accordance with Appendix 7-H (electronic tariff filing system) to the Commission's Codes, Rules and Regulations (16 NYCRR Appendix 7-H).

Effective June 1, 2006

The above revised tariff leaves are being filed pursuant to the Order. Ordering Clause No. 1 directs the Companies to file amended tariffs that would extend the deadline for DG or CHP projects to be in-service, and therefore qualifying for an exemption from standby rates or a phase-in to those rates, from May 31, 2006 to May 31, 2009.

In accordance with Ordering Clause No. 2, the requirement of Public Service Law Section 66(12) (b) as to newspaper publication of the proposed tariff revisions is waived because the Company will directly inform inquiring DG and CHP customers of the deadline extension.
