RE: Village of Bergen – Concurrence Tariff

Dear Secretary Brilling:

Attached please find Original Tariff Leaves Number 1 - 9 of P.S.C. No. 1 – Electricity for the Village of Bergen (the Village) issued February 25, 2008 to be effective June 1, 2008. The Village is a NYMPA member and agrees to abide by the NYMPA Generic Tariff along with the attached Concurrence Tariff which is now being filed electronically with the PSC.

The Village is not changing any rates with this filing, merely making their tariff leaves consistent with current Concurrence Tariff formats and phrasing. Leaf 6 for Service Classification 2 (Small General Service) now indicates that usage will be measured on demand instead of horsepower but it does not change the rate. The Village feels that demand is easier to administer and a more accurate measure of demand on the system given that the old horsepower usage had to be estimated instead of measured.

Permission is requested for a waiver from the Commission's regulations governing newspaper publication since no rate changes are being made.
