Dear Secretary Brillling:

National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation (“Distribution” or the “Company”) submits the following amendment to its tariff, P.S.C. No. 8 - GAS:

Supplement No. 29

The proposed revision is issued as of today for an effective date of November 1, 2007. The Company requests that the Supplement be given “short notice” in order to go into effect on October 21, 2007.

Distribution submitted a tariff amendment proposing to modify its customer aggregation tariff, Service Classification No. 19, Supplier Transportation, Balancing and Aggregation (“STBA”). The proposed revision would authorize a cap on the level of capacity utilized by ESCOs to meet the Company’s firm upstream capacity requirement for STBA service. On September 5, 2007, Distribution filed for postponement of the proposed tariff amendment until October 21, 2007. The sole purpose of this filing is to cancel the proposed tariff amendment, which has become unnecessary given the New York State Public Service Commission’s recent Order on Capacity Release Programs, issued an effective August 30, 2007 in Case 07-G-0299.
