RG&E is establishing an Incremental Gas Supply Charge ("IGSC"), in accordance with the Commission's Order in Case 07-G-0921, Filing by Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation to establish an Incremental Gas Supply Charge for daily metered transportation customers requesting supply service from the Company, Issued and Effective October 17, 2007. The IGSC allows the Company to provide gas supply service to any returning daily metered transportation customer who is no longer served by their Energy Service Company or is without gas supply for some other reason. The IGSC is included in the Incremental Gas Supply Charge Statement, effective November 1, 2007. At the present time, RG&E does not have any such customers.

These rates will continue in effect until there are changes in the cost of gas that require modifications.
